## **Cape Cod British Car Club Toolship Application**

### **A. Eligible Candidates**

1. Candidates must be a full time student in good standing with Upper Cape Cod Technical High School (Bourne MA), Cape Cod Technical High School (Harwich MA), or Plymouth Tech School (Plymouth MA) at the time of the application and selection.
2. There is no discrimination on the basis of age, race, color, national origin, disability, sex (gender), or religion

### **B. Student Qualifications and Conditions**

1. At the time of initial application, the candidate must be a graduating student with Upper Cape Cod Technical High School (Bourne MA), Cape Cod Technical High School (Harwich MA), or Plymouth Tech School (Plymouth MA).
2. The candidate must be enrolled in auto related studies and moving on to more auto related studies and/or entering into an automotive career.

### **C. Limitations**

1. One Toolship in the amount of \$500 will be awarded to each of the three tech schools listed in Part A.1 above for one school year.
2. Toolship winners will be notified by April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2012. Toolships will be paid and delivered directly to the student selected at the Cape Cod British Car Club annual meeting, May 2012.
3. Toolships are not assignable.
4. The application deadline is March 15, 2012.

### **D. Selection Criteria**

1. This is a non-academic scholarship program, appropriately named Toolship. Students applying must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 (C average) or higher. No special consideration will be given for having a higher GPA.
2. Consideration is given to extra curricular automotive related activities.
